
## **GCSE** course overview



Paper 1 (1 hour and 45 minutes)

- Section A (40 marks): **Reading** a C20<sup>th</sup>/21<sup>st</sup> **fiction** text 4 questions
- Section B (40 marks): Writing a descriptive or narrative piece

### Paper 2 (1 hour and 45 minutes)

- Section A (40 marks): **Reading 2 non-fiction** texts: C19<sup>th</sup> and C20<sup>th</sup>/21<sup>st</sup> 4 questions
- Section B (40 marks): Writing a non-fiction piece (5 possible text types e.g. article)

## Literature

Paper 1 (1 hour and 45 minutes)

- Section A (34 marks): **Shakespeare** (*Macbeth* or *Romeo & Juliet*) 2 part question
- Section B (30 marks): 19<sup>th</sup> Century text (A Christmas Carol) 2 part question

#### Paper 2 (2 hours and 15 minutes)

- Section A (34 marks): Modern text (An Inspector Calls) choice of 2 questions
- Section B (30 marks): **Anthology poetry** <u>compare 2 poems</u>
- Section C (32 marks): Unseen poetry 2 questions (one comparative)
