- Made on UCAS Progress online
- Done and chased in school
- Same application for other providers

Interviews

- Start in December, run through to March
- Come in school uniform
- Interview on their own

Admissions Policy

- Any Turton student who gets the grades is guaranteed a place in the sixth form
- Non-holistic approach: just get the grades in the required subjects
- Do require Maths or English grade C (but not both)
- The grades determine the subjects on offer

A-levels or BTECs

• Grade B or above: A-level

• Grade C: BTEC

• BTECs are a very good route to go on to Higher Education

Scenarios

- Student gets the grades needed for the courses they want to do
- No problem place guaranteed

Scenarios

- Student misses the grades for the subjects they want but still gets grades for other courses
- Courses will be offered at interview are they right? Is it what they want to do? Students on the right course are more likely to succeed (ability and enjoyment)
- If they just miss out, Heads of Department are around and may allow them on the course
- Don't leave without talking to someone!

Scenarios

• If the student doesn't get the grades – then looking elsewhere is the right thing to do
