To do	Hacer
I will do	Haré
Will you do?	Harás
he/she/ it / you (polite) will do	Hará
We will do	Haremos
you (plural) will do	Haréis
They will do	Harán

Me acuesto con las gallinas – I go to bed early
 Me acosté con las gallinas – I went to bed early
 Quiero darle vuelta a la tortilla – I want to turn the tables (reverse a situation)
 Es pan comido – It's a piece of cake
 Estoy más sano/a que una pera – I'm as fit as a fiddle
 Soy un ave nocturna – I am a night owl

Mi madre me dice que– my mum says that
El deporte me da - sport gives me
Mi madre me dio my mum gave me
Lo hago/practico – I do/practise it
Lo/ la gasto en - I spend it on
Me chifla hacerlo- I love doing it
Ojalá hiciera más deporte – If only I did more sport
Ojalá tuviera más tiempo – If only I had more time
