Vivo – I live
Vivimos – we live
Veo – I watch
Vemos – we watch
Leo – I read
Leemos – we read
Como – I eat
Comemos – we eat

Key structures/verbs
Hay – there is/are
No hay – there isn't – REMEMBER: don't use un/una afterwards!
Es – (it) is
Son – (they) are
Tengo – I have

Possessive
Possessives are used to explain who something belongs to.
my brother's bedroom
= El dormitorio de mi hermano
= the bedroom of my brother
My parents' bedroom
= el dormitorio de mis padres
= the bedroom of my parents

It is
Es - it is for descriptions
Es grande = it's big

Está – it is for locations, to say where something is
Está a la derecha de = it's to the right of
