Key ideas

Opinions (+ infinitive or nouns)

- Me gusta – I like
 Me encanta – I love
 Me gusta mucho – I really like
 No me gusta – I don't like
 No me gusta nada – I really don't like
 Odio – I hate
 Prefiero – I prefer
 Pienso que – I think that
 Me gustaría – I would like



Weather

In Spanish it's not it is cold but rather it makes cold (as in the weather makes cold)

- Hace frío – It *makes cold (it is cold)
 Hace calor – It is hot
 Hace viento – It is windy
 Hace buen tiempo – It is good weather
 Hace mal tiempo – It is bad weather

Present tense verbs take off the “-ar / -er / -ir” then add:			
	practicar	Hacer	Escribir
I	Practico	*Hago	Escribo
Do you...?	¿Practicas?	¿haces?	¿bebes?
We	Practicamos	Hacemos	Escribimos

Conditional tense

The conditional tense is used to express something that would happen

e.g. *Me gustaría jugar* – I would like to play

This is how it is formed:

Me gustaría + infinitive - I would like + infinitive

For a list of useful infinitives see the box below

Key structures/verbs

- Es – (it) is
 Son – (they) are
 Suelo + infinitive – I usually / I tend to...
No le gusta + infinitive – he/she doesn't like

Key infinitives

- Practicar – To practise
 Jugar – To play
 Hacer – To do
 Nadar – To swim

IRREGULAR VERBS IN THE PRESENT TENSE

- Jugar – To play
 Juego – I play
 Juegas – You play
 Juega – He/she plays
 Jugamos – We play

- Hacer – To do
 Hago – I do
 Haces – You do
 Hace – He/she does
 Hacemos – We do

Connectives

- Porque – because
 Pero – but
 Sin embargo – however
 También – also
 Además – furthermore
 Cuando - when

Key vocabulary: when?

- El lunes – on Monday
 El martes – on Tuesday
 El miércoles – on Wednesday
 El jueves – on Thursday
 El viernes – on Friday
 El sábado – on Saturday
 El domingo – on Sunday
 Por la mañana – in the morning
 Por la tarde – in the afternoon/evening
 Por la noche – at night
 Después del colegio – after school
 La semana que viene – next week

Key vocabulary: frequency expressions

- A menudo – often
 A veces – sometimes
 Nunca – never
 Siempre – always

Key vocabulary : adjectives

- Interesante - interesting
 Guay - cool
 Divertido/a - fun
 Estúpido/a - stupid
 Aburrido/a – boring

- Primero – first
 Luego – then
 Finalmente - finally
