este fin de semana this weekend
mañana tomorrow
la semana que viene next week

Future Tense

voy a	I am going
vas a	you are going
va a	he/she is going
vamos a	we are going
vais a	you (pl) are going
van a	they are going

Giving an opinion in the future

va a ser divertido it is going to be fun

Extension: Use **tanto** which means **so much** or **so many**

hay – there is / are
no hay – there isn't
there aren't

**No need to include the
indefinite article
(un/una) after no hay**
