You may need to complete a graph or chart. Using a pencil allows you to rub out mistakes as well as shade neatly.</li> <li>Don't forget to bring a calculator to the exams. In the skills paper you will need to manipulate data in some way. This could include adding different categories together, working out percentages, medians or means.</li> <li>Always have a go at every question. Don't leave blank pages.</li> </ul>
