Hints or tips for success	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learn all your case studies in detail.• Remember to always read each section carefully before beginning your answer.• Make sure you are aware of which element of any case study a question refers to.• Have a plan for 8 and 12 mark questions.• Bring a pen and a pencil, a ruler and rubber. You may need to complete a graph or chart. Using a pencil allows you to rub out mistakes as well as shade neatly.• Don't forget to bring a calculator to the exams. In the skills paper you will need to manipulate data in some way. This could include adding different categories together, working out percentages, medians or means.• Always have a go at every question. Don't leave blank pages.
