

## **History Homework**

All History Key Stage Three History homework will be assigned online using **Microsoft Teams**.

## **Homework Schedule**

History homework will follow the school weekly schedule, ensuring students know what to expect and when tasks are due. Assignments will be posted directly by History teachers on Teams.

## **What sorts of tasks will students do?**

Students will engage in a variety of activities designed to deepen their understanding of historical topics. These will include:

- **Comprehension exercises** to reinforce key concepts
- **Investigative tasks** that encourage critical thinking and independent research
- **Project-based assignments** to develop creativity and collaboration

## **What will the Homework cover?**

Homework will link to the students' units of study. In year seven they will cover: Norman England, Medieval Britain, and The Islamic World. In year eight: Early Modern England, Industry and Empire, and The Civil Rights Movements. In year nine: The Rise of the Dictators, WWII, The Holocaust, and Cold War Tensions.

Homework will also incorporate **interleaving**, a method that revisits previously learned, preparation for future topics, and topics material. This approach helps students make connections across different historical periods and themes, improving long-term retention.

## **How will Homework be checked?**

Teachers will check homework completion online and as part of their **weekly review tasks**. This ensures students stay on track and receive timely feedback to support their progress.
